

## **RECREATION COMMITTEE MEMO**

The Recreation Committee did not hold a formal meeting on Sunday, January 9. Instead there was email consultation and telephone consultations about matters that concerned the Committee. Those members involved were Julie Gilmore, Mark Reilly, Sandy Beck and Kay Quirk, and myself.

### **Exercise Room:**

Management has tried to find an elliptical machine on sale for the price that the Board had approved. This does not seem to be possible. Management proposes that the Board at this January meeting approve additional funds for the purchase of an elliptical machine. Committee members support this proposal and ask the Board to approve the additional funding.

The Committee would like to point out that the elliptical machine has been according to the reserve study scheduled for replacement for the last eight years. And, as confirmed by a few residents and users of the room, the machine is at present making strange noises which would indicate that an axle needs replacing. The axle has been replaced before so the noise is one that is understood. The machine will have to be fixed. The machine has had to have many repairs in the last two or three years. Replacement seems to be the best option.

### **Tennis Courts:**

Management has assured the Committee that Valley Drive tennis court resurfacing will be completed in spring. The Committee will be monitoring this and looking forward to the Valley Drive tennis courts once again being playable.

### **Pools:**

The Committee has been told that the pool management contract for the 2012 pool season will be considered at the March Board meeting. The pool management contract has been sent out for bid and the bids will be returned in late February. Lynn Humphries worked with Sarah Clark on different options for the pools. Committee members await the receipt of the bids and finding out what the options will cost. The Committee will make its recommendations for the pool management contract when the bids are in and for the March meeting. Committee members hope that all three pools will be open for the 2012 pool season.
